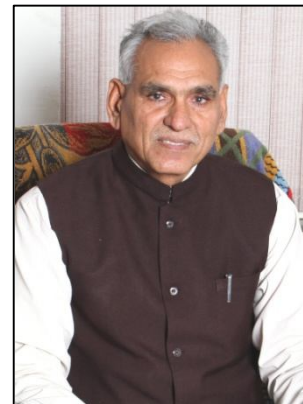

Experience

Mr. Chaudhary started his career as a lecturer in a government college in 1971 after being selected in R.E.S services by the R.P.S.C. He spent seven years in college education, working as a lecturer in Govt. College Sirohi, Dausa and Ajmer.

Mr. Chaudhary was selected in Rajasthan Administrative Services in 1977. During his long and illustrious administrative career, Mr. Chaudhary served as an Assistant Collector and Sub Divisional Magistrate for five years at Shahpura, Kekri, Udaipur. He also served as Add. Collector & Add. Distt. Magistrate at Baran, Ajmer and Jaipur. He has also been the Commissioner of Municipal Council, Ajmer as well as the Secretary, UIT, Ajmer. Mr. Chaudhary also had more than one-and-a-half-year tenure in the Secretariat as Dy. Secretary, D.O.P.
