ORDER

1. Mr Amitesh Kumar has placed before this court the "incident report". I have perused the contents of the report and the photographs, appended thereto. Prima facie, it appears, that there has been some violence at the campus. The report is taken on record.

1.1 However, apart from the above, Mr Amitesh Kumar has returned with instructions to the following effect:

(i) That the campuses under the Footwear Design & Development Institute (in short the institute) located at Noida, Fursatganj, Kolkata, Chennai, Chhindwara, Rohtak & Jodhpur, will commence classes from 19.10.2015.

(ii) That mess facilities would also be extended to hostellers.

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(ii)(a) In view of the fact that on the previous date it was indicated that classes will commence from 16.10.2015, these facilities will be extended to the hostellers from 16.10.2015.

(iii) The institute will approach the concerned Superintendent of Police and the District Magistrate for putting in place the requisite security measures so that there is no incident of violence on the various campuses of the institute referred to hereinabove.

2. Accordingly, the concerned Superintendent of Police or Police officer of equivalent rank and the District Magistrate are directed to render all possible assistance to the institute on the Director of the campus/ CMD of the institute approaching them. Adequate and requisite arrangements will be made by the police and civil administration in that behalf. Intercession of the police will only take place at the request of the Director of the concerned campus or the CMD of the institute. If police is deployed, it will ensure that it acts with utmost restraint in dealing with the situation keeping in mind that they would be dealing with young students.

3. Furthermore, the Secretary in the Ministry of Commerce, Government of India, is requested to convene a meeting with the Chairperson of the UGC, CMD of the institute and Chancellor of the Mewar University so as to find a resolution, at the earliest, qua the issue arising in the matter.

3.1 The result of the meeting will be minuted, and the minutes of the meeting will be placed before the court, before the next date of hearing.

4. Furthermore, the institute will, forthwith, upload on their official website the order of this court dated 21.09.2015 and the order passed today.

5. With the aforesaid directions, the application is disposed of.
