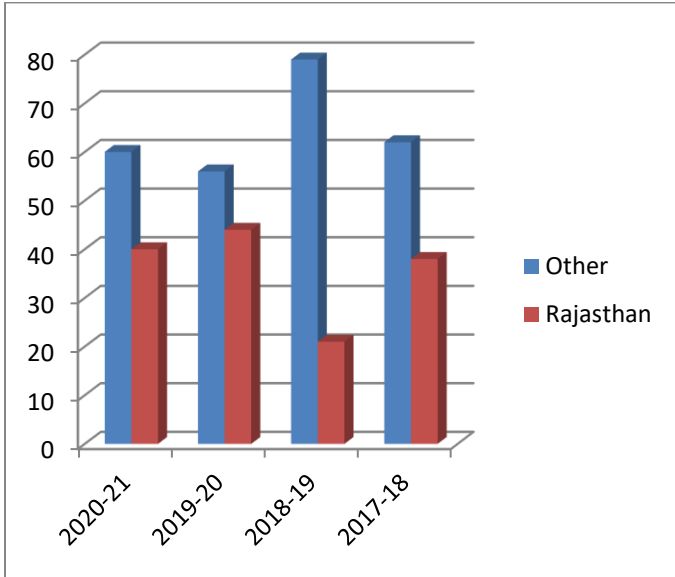


Figure 1: MU Gangrar is home to students from all over the country and overseas in which approx 35% are from Raj.

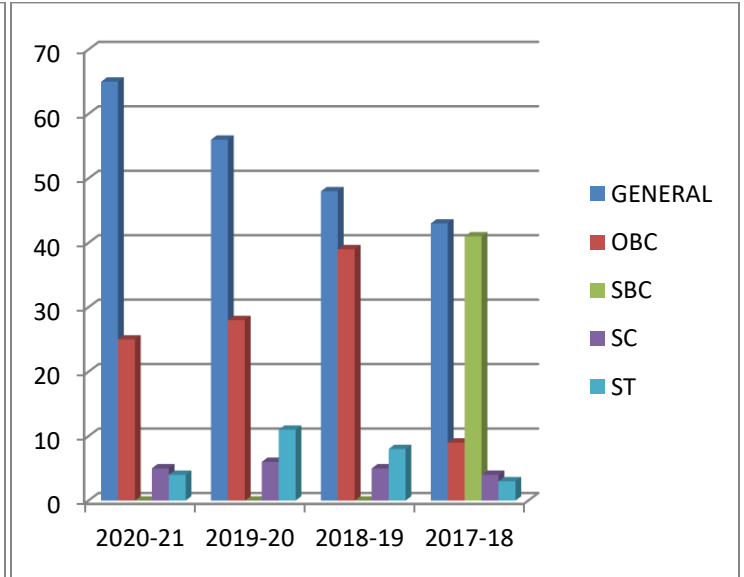


Figure 2: Ratio of students belonging from different categories of society. MU welcomes all of its students with equality & believes in right to education for everyone.

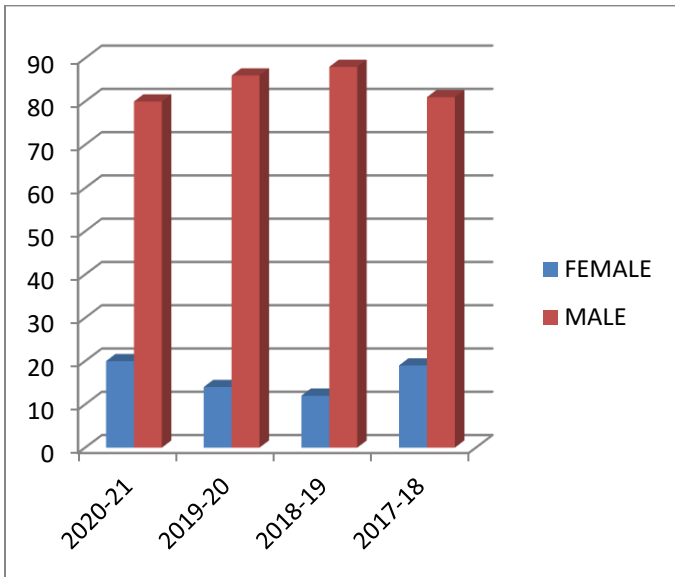


Figure 3: MU has approx. 20% of female students. The gap in ratio of female to male has lessened in past 3 years, MU continues to spread awareness about RTE(Right to Education) & BBBP(Beti Bachao,Beti Padhao).

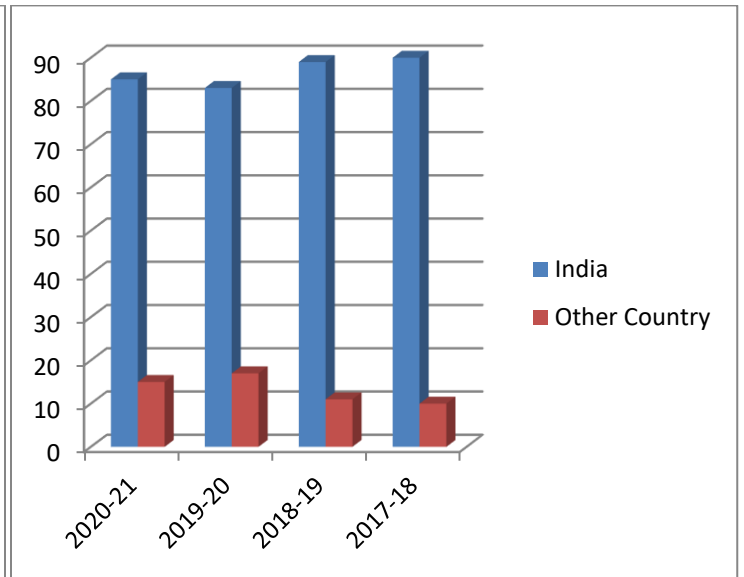


Figure 4: MU offers a Diverse Campus Environment with around 15% Foreign students in campus creating a Progressive and Enriching learning Environment.

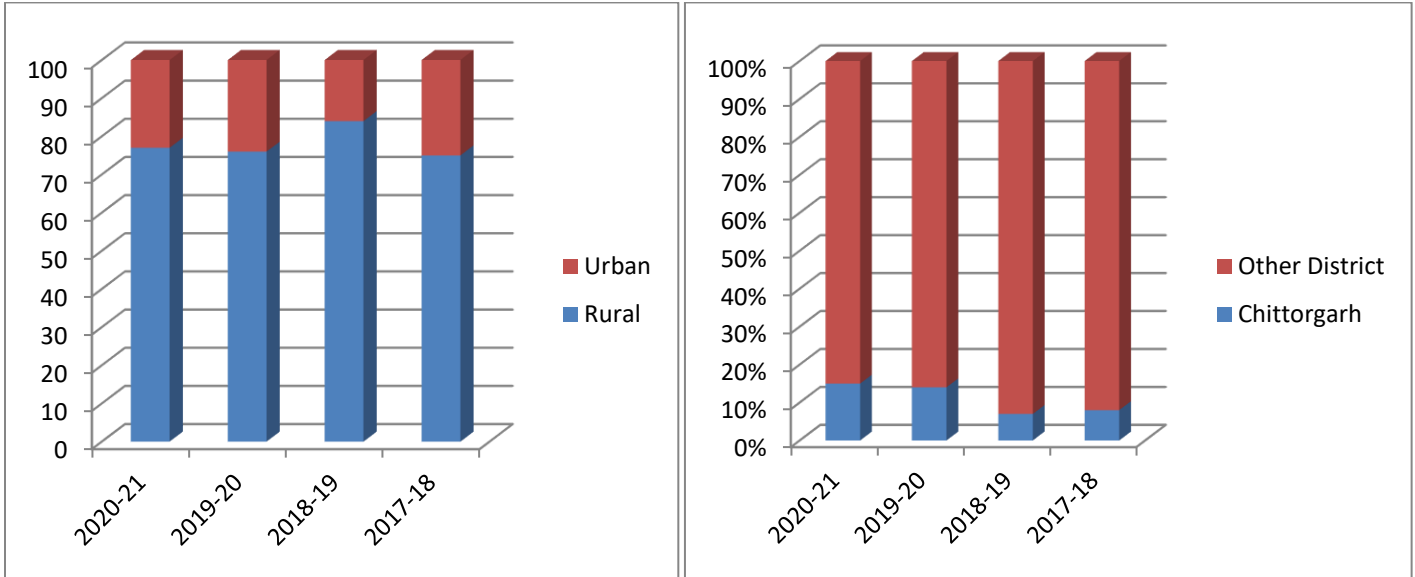


Figure5: Our mission from the start was to “Reach the Unreached” and we have been successful in it as 70-75 % of the population of students comprises from Rural areas.
